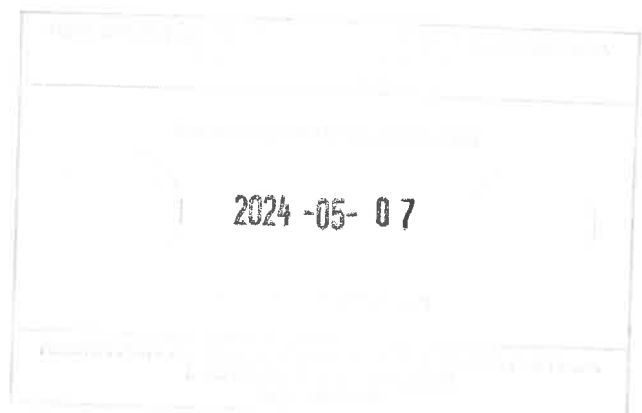

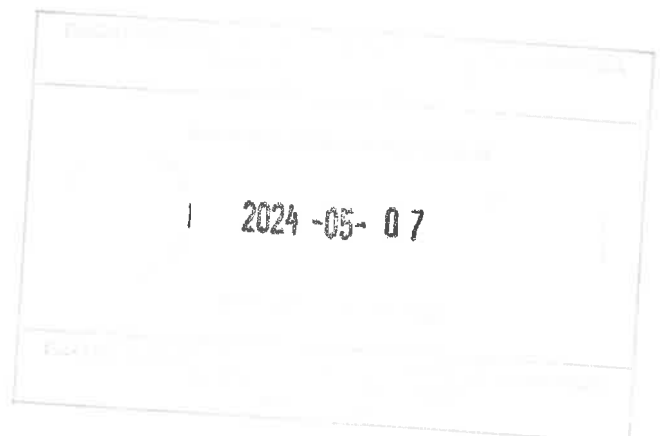

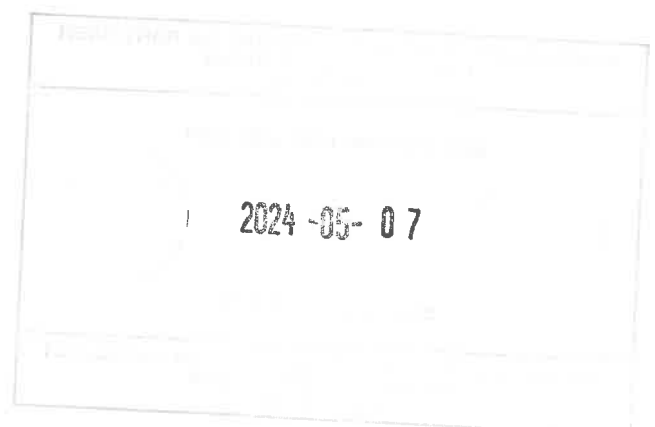
ORDER

Having heard Adv. Somandi, Counsel for the Applicant and having read the Notice of Motion and other documents filed of record

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The non-compliance with the Uniform Rules of Court, relating to the service and the time periods in terms of Rule 6(12) be and is hereby condoned.

2. A Rule *nisi* do hereby issue calling upon the Respondents to show cause, if any, to this Honourable Court on **TUESDAY 21 May 2024** at 09h30, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, as to why a final order interdicting and restraining the First to Twenty - Seventh Respondent, and any person acting through, under or in concern with the First to Twenty-Seven Respondent from:
 - a. Threatening and/or intimidating the Applicant, its employees, its subcontractors, suppliers , students and all other personnel of the Applicant (collectively referred to as the **protected persons**), attending to work/ enter/ exit at the Applicant's premises situated at 1



Amatola Row, King William's Town, Eastern Cape and 1 Gert Goosen Road, Zwelitsha (**the premises**);

- b. Entering, interfering or otherwise disrupting the business operations and functioning carried out in the premises;
 - c. Obstructing or otherwise interrupting the free and uninhibited flow of traffic from and to the premises;
 - d. Inciting, encouraging or directing any person or persons to commit the acts set out in paragraphs 2.1 (a) to (d) above.
3. The Twenty-Eighth Respondent provides such assistance and protection to the Sheriff of this Honourable Court as he may require for the purposes of the service of this application and service and execution of any order granted by this Honourable Court.
 4. The Twenty-Eighth Respondent be and are hereby directed to assist with the execution of this Honourable Courts order insofar as it may be necessary in relation to, *inter alia*, providing free and inhibited access to the property.
 5. The Respondents that unsuccessfully oppose this application be and are hereby directed to pay the costs of this application, jointly and severally, the one paying the others to be absolved on the scale and between attorney and client.

6. The order referred to in paragraphs 2(a) to 2(d) above shall serve as an interim interdict with immediate effect, pending the return date.

7. The Applicant be and is hereby directed to serve the application and this court order in the following manner:
 1. The application and the court order be published on the Applicant's webpage;

 2. The First to Twenty-Sixth Respondent be served with the application and the court order by sending the aforementioned to known email addresses;

 3. The court order be affixed to the Applicant's main gate and notice board by the sheriff.
