The Lovedale TVET College invites contractors with a CIDB Grading of **1GB Only** in the following Class of works (**GB**) to tender for **REPAIRS AND RENOVATION TO THE HALL AND ADMIN BUILDING AT LOVEDALE TVET COLLEGE KING WILLIAMS TOWN CAMPUS** for a 5 months' contract. The contract will be based on the JBCC Edition 4.1 and Lovedale TVET College will enter a contract with the successful tenderer.

Only tenderers who have suitable experience and suitably qualified personnel in providing similar services to those that are required are eligible to submit tenders.

Tender documents will be available as from **08H00** on Monday the **18 June 2024** from the offices of the **Lovedale TVET College, 1 Amatola Row, Headquarters King Williams Town, 5601** upon a payment of non-refundable fee of **R300.00** (Three Hundred rand) for each document (by means of a bank guaranteed cheque made directly to Lovedale TVET College or EFT using the following banking details:

Completed Tender documents in a sealed envelope endorsed with the relevant bid number, bid description and the closing date must be deposited in the bid box not later than **11H00 am, Tuesday 09 July 2024.**

Bidders must ensure that bids submitted via courier services are deposited by the courier service in the College bid box prior to the closing date and that it is not delivered to college officials. The College will not accept responsibility if bids received by officials are not timely deposited in the Bid Box.

B. BID EVALUATION:

This bid will be evaluated in three (3) phases as follows:

Phase One: Prequalification: Compliance, responsiveness to the bid rules and conditions, thereafter they will be evaluated on PPPFA.

Phase Two: Bidders passing all stages above will thereafter be evaluated on PPPFA.

PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT POLICY FRAMEWORK ACT (PPPFA) POINTS WILL BE AWARDED AS FOLLOWS:

C. BID SPECIFICATIONS, CONDITIONS AND RULES

The minimum specifications, other bid conditions and rules are detailed in the bid document under Tender Data.

The specifications, rules, special conditions of bid, evaluation criteria, and rules for evaluation for compliance to local content and other bid conditions are detailed in the document.

Only locally produced goods or services with a stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content of 100 % (Designated sector: Steel Components and Products) will be considered.

Exchange rate to be used for the calculation of local content (local content and local production are used interchangeably) must be the exchange rate published by the SARB at 12:00 on the date, one week (7 calendar days) prior to the closing date of the bid.

If the raw material or input to be used for a specific item is not available locally, bidders should obtain written authorization from the DTI should there be a need to import such raw material or input; and a copy of the authorization letter from DTI must be submitted together with the bid/quotation document at the closing date and time.

The Lovedale TVET College SCM policy applies.
